Adjournment: Meeting adjourned at 1940 hours. Moved by Earl McMullin, seconded by Blair Saulnier

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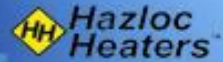

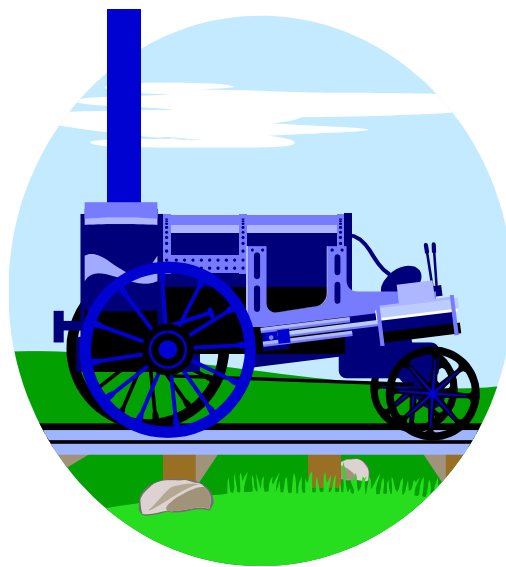
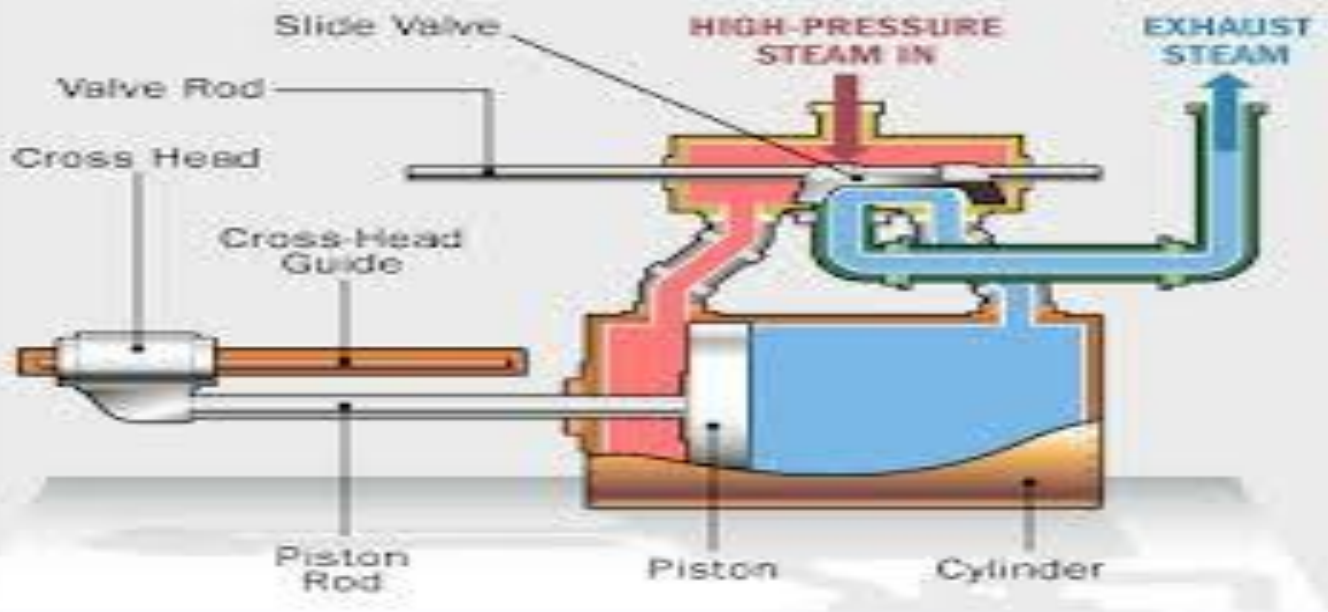
